PRIVACY NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PARTICIPANTS' PERSONAL DATA

1. DATA CONTROLLER

Within the scope of the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 ("KVKK"), your personal data are processed by Telateks Tekstil Ürünleri San. ve Tic. A.Ş. (the "Company"), whose details are provided below, in its capacity as data controller.

2. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

Within the scope of the METYX Aerospace & Defense Forum 2026, to be held on 11 November 2026 at Bilkent Hotel Ankara, the following personal data may be processed:

Identity information:

- Name and surname

Professional information:

- Company/organization
- Position/title

Contact information:

- Telephone number
- Email

Visual and audio data:

- Photographs and video footage that may be recorded during the event
- Audio recordings that may be included in video recordings

Photographs, video footage and audio recordings will only be processed if you provide separate explicit consent.

3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

Your name and surname, company/organization, position/title and telephone number are processed for the purposes of:

- Receiving event applications and participant registrations,
- Creating the participant list,
- Verifying participants' identity and company information,
- Preparing name badges,
- Sharing the event programme, transportation information and other organizational details,

- Planning attendance for the dinner to be held following the Forum,
- Contacting participants before, during or after the event when necessary,
- Ensuring that the event is conducted safely and in an orderly manner,
- Responding to participants' requests and questions,
- Carrying out administrative and operational processes relating to the event

for these purposes.

In addition, if you provide explicit consent, your photographs, video footage and audio recordings will be processed for the purposes of:

- Documenting the event internally within the Company,
- Preparing event reports,
- Creating records of corporate activities,
- Creating the Company's internal archive relating to the event

for these purposes.

4. INFORMATION ON PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING

Photographs and video recordings covering general areas and event activities may be taken throughout the event.

For participants who have provided explicit consent, such images will be used solely for documenting and reporting the event internally within the Company and for creating the corporate archive.

Unless your separate explicit consent is obtained, your images will not be published on social media accounts, the website, printed materials or other publicly accessible communication channels, nor will they be used for promotional purposes.

For portraits, interviews or special recordings in which a specific individual is directly in focus, the relevant person will be informed separately and, where necessary, separate explicit consent will be obtained.

Refusing to provide explicit consent for photography and video recording will not affect your participation in the event. If you do not wish to be photographed or recorded, you may communicate this request to the event registration desk or authorized personnel.

5. METHOD OF COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data are collected through:

- The event registration form,
- Email and telephone communications,
- Participant information provided by authorized representatives of the relevant companies,
- Information obtained at the event entrance or during the event,

- Photographs and video recordings taken during the event, if you provide explicit consent,

by written, verbal, electronic, visual or audio means.

If an online registration form is used, records relating to the date and time the form was submitted and your privacy notice and explicit consent preferences may also be retained electronically.

6. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

Your name and surname, company/organization, position/title and telephone number are processed on the legal basis set out in Article 5(2)(f) of the KVKK, namely that processing is necessary for the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that such processing does not prejudice the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject.

Your photographs, video footage and audio recordings will be processed on the basis of the explicit consent you provide pursuant to Article 5(1) of the KVKK.

7. TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data may be transferred, only to the extent necessary and proportionate for achieving the purposes stated above, to:

- Authorized Company employees involved in organizing the event,
- Suppliers providing organization and event services,
- Suppliers providing name badge printing services,
- Service providers responsible for the hotel where the event will be held and for the dinner organization,
- If you provide explicit consent, service providers that provide photography, video recording or technical processing services on behalf of the Company and are subject to confidentiality obligations,
- Public institutions and authorities legally authorized for the purpose of fulfilling legal obligations.

Such transfers may be made only within the scope described above.

Your personal data will not be used for advertising, promotional activities or the sending of commercial electronic communications unless separate permission is obtained.

Your photographs, video footage and audio recordings will not be published through publicly accessible communication channels or transferred abroad unless your separate explicit consent is obtained.

8. RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA

Your name and surname, company/organization, position/title and telephone number will be retained for the period necessary to hold the event, complete the administrative and organizational processes relating to the event and, where applicable, fulfil legal obligations.

If you provide explicit consent, photographs, video footage and audio recordings will be retained for the period necessary to document and report the event and create the Company's internal archive.

Once the purposes and legal grounds requiring the processing of personal data cease to exist, your data will be deleted, destroyed or anonymized in accordance with the applicable legislation and the Company's personal data retention and destruction procedures.

9. SECURITY OF PERSONAL DATA

Our Company takes the necessary technical and administrative measures pursuant to Article 12 of the KVKK to prevent the unlawful processing of and unlawful access to personal data and to ensure the secure storage of personal data.

Within this scope:

- Access to personal data is restricted to authorized persons who need access to such information due to their duties,
- User authorization, access controls, password security and necessary information security measures are implemented in electronic systems,
- Physical documents are stored in a manner that prevents access by unauthorized persons,
- Third parties from whom services are obtained within the scope of the event are required to act in accordance with confidentiality and data security obligations,
- Personal data are processed in a manner that is relevant, limited and proportionate to the purposes of processing,
- Technical and administrative measures relating to data security are assessed in line with current risks and updated where necessary.

Access to photographs, video footage and audio recordings will be limited to personnel authorized and assigned for the purposes of documenting and reporting the event and creating the internal corporate archive.

10. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

Pursuant to Article 11 of the KVKK, you have the right to apply to the data controller to:

- Learn whether your personal data are being processed,
- Request information if your personal data have been processed,
- Learn the purpose of processing your personal data and whether they are being used in accordance with that purpose,
- Know the third parties to whom your personal data are transferred in Türkiye or abroad,
- Request correction of your personal data if they have been processed incompletely or inaccurately,
- Request deletion or destruction of your personal data within the framework of the conditions set forth in Article 7 of the KVKK,
- Request notification of correction, deletion or destruction operations to third parties to whom your personal data have been transferred,
- Object to any result arising against you as a result of the analysis of your processed personal data exclusively through automated systems,
- Request compensation for damages if you suffer damage due to the unlawful processing of your personal data.

You have the rights listed above.

You may withdraw at any time the explicit consent you have given for the processing of your photographs, video footage and audio recordings. Withdrawal of explicit consent will take effect prospectively from the date your request reaches our Company.

12. APPLICATION METHODS

Pursuant to Article 13(1) of the Personal Data Protection Law, you may submit your request to exercise the rights set out above using the methods and information below in accordance with the “Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles of Application to the Data Controller”, published on 10 March 2018 under No. 30356.

Information required in the application:

1. Name and surname of the applicant.
2. Turkish ID Number if the applicant is a citizen of the Republic of Türkiye; if not, nationality together with passport number or, if available, identification number.
3. Residential or workplace address of the applicant for notification purposes.
4. Email address, telephone or fax number of the applicant for notification purposes.
5. Subject of the request.
6. Information and documents relating to the subject of the applicant’s request.

Application Methods:

1. The applicant may apply in person to the address of Telateks Tekstil Ürünleri San. ve Tic. A.Ş. by completing an “Application Form” and delivering it by hand to the reception office in a sealed envelope, against a delivery record, with the note “Information Request Pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Law” written on the envelope.
2. The applicant may send a notification through a notary public to the address of Telateks Tekstil Ürünleri San. ve Tic. A.Ş.; however, the notification envelope must bear the note “Information Request Pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Law”.
- 3. Using a “Secure Electronic Signature” as defined under Electronic Signature Law No. 5070, the applicant may personally submit an application to our Company’s Registered Electronic Mail (KEP) address, telatekstekstil@hs01.kep.tr, with “Information Request Pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Law” in the subject line.

The application envelope must be marked “Information Request under the Personal Data Protection Law”.

Our Company will conclude your application under the KVKK as soon as possible depending on the nature of the request and, in any event, within 30 days at the latest.

In light of this Privacy Notice, the personal data belonging to you that you have shared with us and that we process/will process in our capacity as data controller are specified above. Within the framework of the principles explained in the above Privacy Notice of our Company, we request your explicit consent to the processing of your personal data in accordance with the KVKK and applicable legislation.
